What We Believe

The Chapel at CrossPoint will love and worship God; introduce people to the Lord Jesus Christ; encourage them to grow and mature in their faith, with an uncompromising commitment to the Holy Bible, the inspired, inerrant, infallible Word of God; and equip them for service through the power of the Spirit. Matthew 22:37-39, Ephesians 4:12)

We accept the Scriptures as our sole authority in all matters of faith and practice, and adopt the following Statement of Faith as our interpretation of Bible Doctrine:

We believe the Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments as verbally inspired of God and inerrant in the original writings, and that they are of supreme and final authority.

We believe in one God eternally existing in three persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit; three in one, co-equal, which is the Trinity.

We believe that Jesus Christ was begotten of God, conceived of the Holy Spirit, and born of the Virgin Mary.
